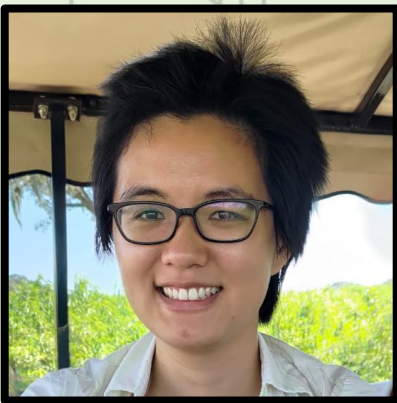


Experience of Mathematicians as Parents: Challenges, what's great about it, and what we can do better
