

Accessing MATLAB off-campus

How to use UF Apps to access MATLAB software

Step 1 – Install Citrix Receiver


1. Download Citrix Receiver at <http://www.citrix.com/go/receiver.html>.
2. Once it has downloaded, run the .exe file.
3. Follow the steps to setup the Citrix Receiver on your device.



Note: You will only have to do this step once on each device you use.

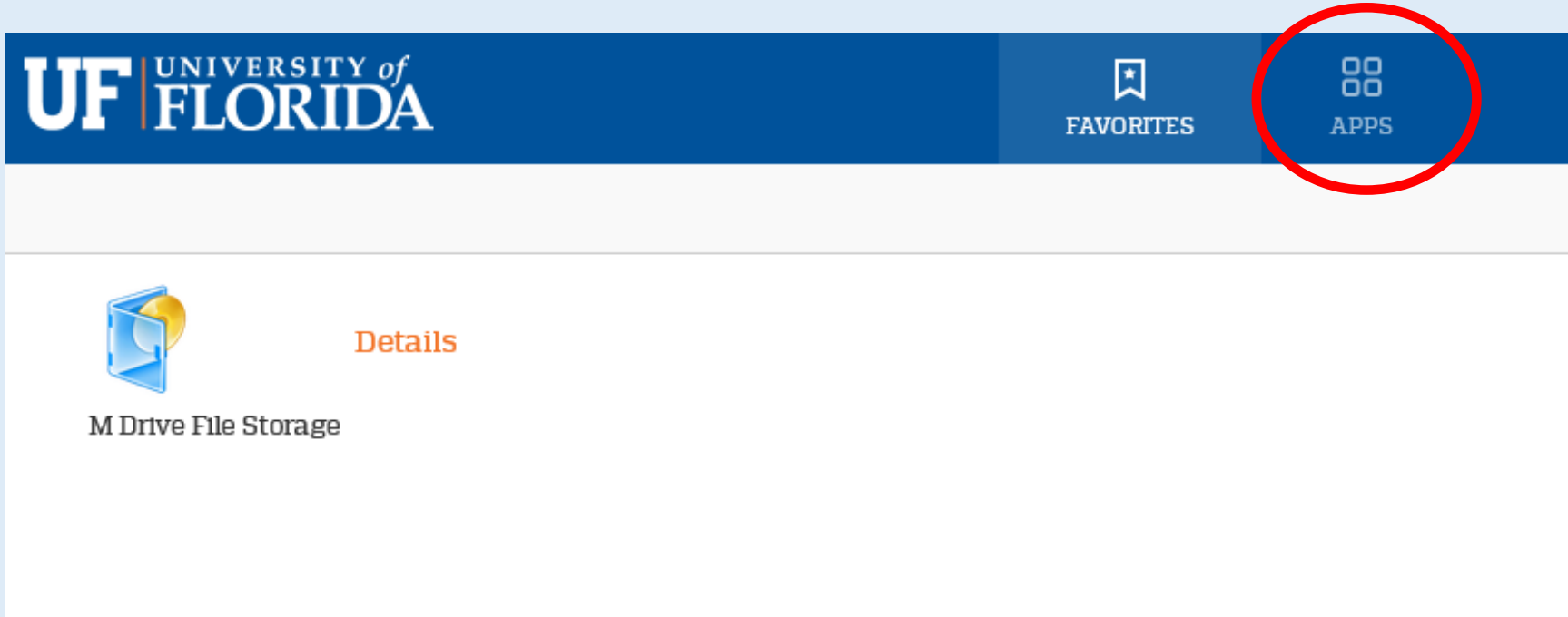
Step 2 – Login to UF Apps

1. Go to info.apps.ufl.edu and click “Login to UF Apps.”
2. Sign in using your gatorlink ID and password.

2. Check your browser's address bar and allow the app to run Citrix Receiver.
3. Click Permit Use to allow Citrix Receiver to run.
